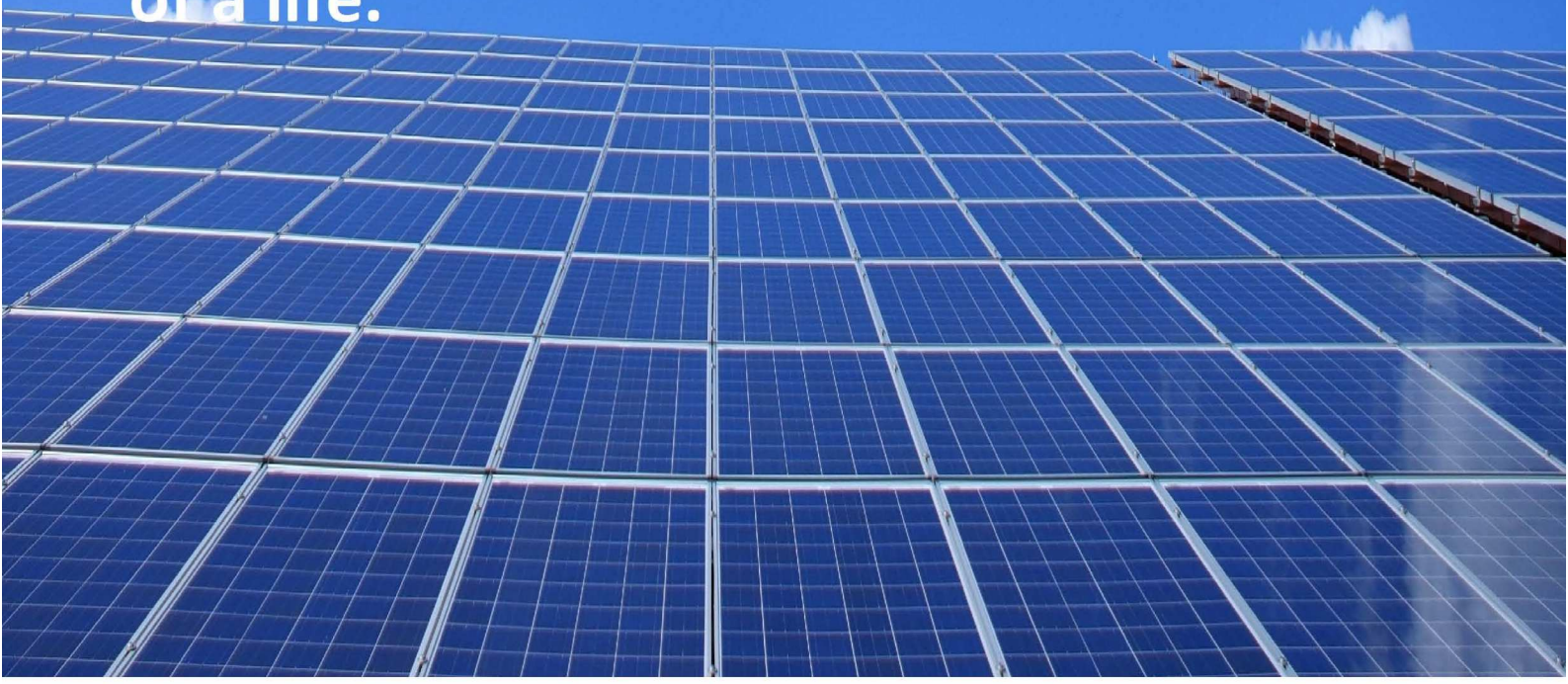


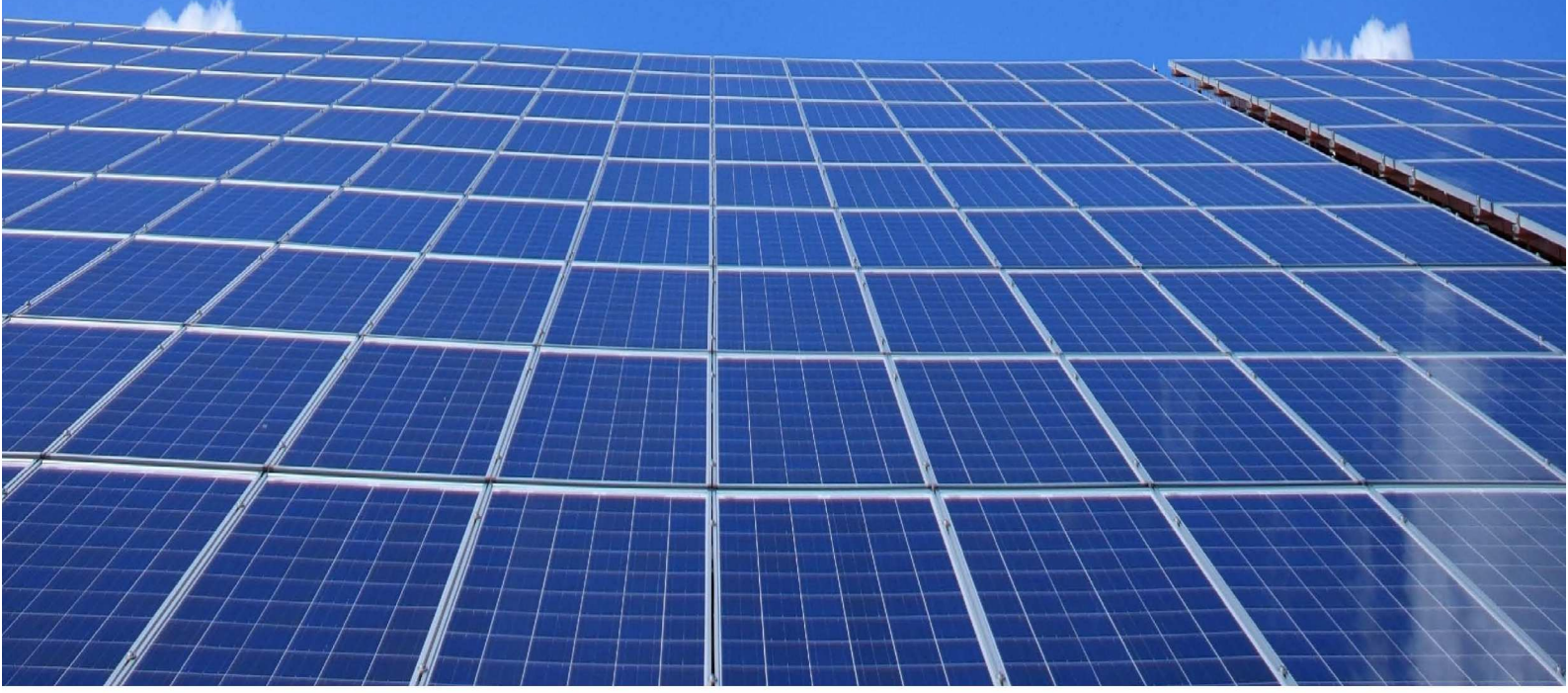
"How to choose a *RIGHT* INSTITUTE ?" Booklet
